• To Discuss the Budget and make recommendations for the Precept Meeting

Councillors present reviewed the current budget and the projected budget moving forward.

Resolved:

1. To recommend to Full Council a precept of £151,000.00 which is an increase of 2.14% based upon the new Tax base of 1825 previously 1809. This will mean and increase of £1.73 per property and an increase of £0.0333 pence per week, as per the tax base of 1825 properties.

- 2. To recommend to Full Council the supporting of a previous decision to replace £10,000.00 previously taken from the reserves, enabling the council to meet its liabilities.
- 3. To recommend to Full Council moving balances of budget costs to reserves to allow Council greater ability to fund replacement equipment and enable the Council to have strengthened funding for future projects and accounting requirements, these areas currently to be Information Technology, Elections, Cemetery infrastructure maintenance, Street Lighting, CCTV, War Memorial Repairs, Notice Boards, Poppies for Remembrance Sunday
